

JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Dance Teacher

Reports to: Principal

Role Overview: The Dance Teacher will be responsible for planning and delivering structured dance education to students in alignment with the CBSE co-curricular framework. The role focuses on developing students' rhythm, coordination, expression, confidence and creativity, while preparing them for school events, performances and competitions.

Brief of Duties and responsibilities: -

- Plan and conduct dance classes suitable for different age groups as per school guidelines.
- Prepare structured lessons plans aligned with creativity, learning outcomes and academic calendar
- Teach various dance forms (Indian classical/folk, contemporary, Western, or freestyle) as applicable.
- Develop students' rhythm, coordination, posture, expression and stage presence.
- Prepare students for school assemblies, cultural programs, competitions and annual functions.
- Encourage creativity, self-esteem, confidence and teamwork through dance activities.
- Ensure student safety during practice sessions and performances.
- Support inter-school competitions and community events.
- Maintain discipline and a positive learning environment during dance classes.
- Assess student participation, progress and performance periodically.
- Maintain lesson plans, attendance and performance records.
- Coordinate with music teachers and event coordinators for performances.
- Ensure proper use, care, and storage of sound systems and dance-related equipment.
- Promote appreciation of Indian culture, traditions and global dance forms.
- Participate in school meetings, rehearsals and professional development programs.
- Maintain professionalism and courteous behaviour with students, parents and staff.
- Uphold school values, discipline and CBSE guidelines.

- Postgraduate/ Graduate in classical Dance/ Contemporary form with rich experience in showcasing events

Experience: 2–4 years of teaching or performing experience as a Dance Teacher (school experience preferred).

Key Skills & Competencies:

- Strong knowledge of one or more dance forms.
- Ability to engage and motivate students of different age groups.
- Creativity, energy and enthusiasm for teaching dance.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Strong classroom and rehearsal management skills.
